## Narvik Campaign Shield Navy Gold Version in Zinc Unknown Maker

## **Description**

The Narvik Arm Shield was the 1st Campaign Shield to be instituted by Adolf Hitler on 19<sup>th</sup> August 1940. This shield was authorized for all members of the Army Navy and Air Force who took part in the campaign around Narvik in Norway between 9<sup>th</sup> April 1940 – 9<sup>th</sup> June 1940. The Navy Version was normally mounted on a Navy Blue backing Cloth. It came in Metallic / Zinc and Silver / Gold versions.
