Description

Per Hitler's decree on November 13, 1933 all persons with uninterrupted service in the NSDAP since February 27, 1925 with membership numbers between 1 and 100,000 would receive the newly instituted Golden Party Badge. The 30MM badge was designed for wear on a political or military uniform with the owner's party number stamped or engraved on the reverse.

The badge has the "civilian" style pin on the reverse. The original owner apparently tried to remove the engraved party number. While the enamel has a few cracks, it does not have any chips. The badge was also awarded with a wide, vertical pin referred to by collectors as the "Military Pin".
