## Kriegsmarine Coastal Artillery Badge Otto Placzek, Berlin Designer C. E. Juncker, Berlin Maker

## **Description**

The coastal artillery service was the Kriegsmarine branch responsible for protecting the Reich's coastal borders from both air and sea attack. On June 24, 1941 Grand Admiral Raeder instituted the War Badge of the Coastal Artillery to reward the actions of both individuals and crew members.
